Description

Large ball-shaped vase (the curvature of the flat handles joins the body of the vase and gives a general circular shape to the whole...) in stoneware with a beige background, dotted with blue crystallized enamels. The beginning of the technique of Crystallized enamel dates from the end of the 19th century and was discovered by accident. This crystallization gives a beautiful, surprising and magical decoration, evoking a starry sky, or flowers and relief on the flat surface (the blue appears hollow).. Used in the era of ART NOUVEAU. This technique was also used later by the BAHAUS. This type of crystallized enamel was abandoned after the war because it was too uncertain. The ball-shaped vase with thick flat handles typical of ART DECO is from the 1930s, its broad shape highlights the sowing
