Museum quality hornbill type Kota bird knife It is an onzil/osele, but by mistake these knives are called throwing knives, although they were never intended to be used as a weapon. They are mostly ceremonial and also used in some religious processions. The shape of the blade is in the style of the head of the Hornbill, a bird much admired in Africa, hence the usual title "bird's head knife". Most likely originating from the Kota people of Gabon and later adopted by the Fang and other
