- o Vieillard 1er titre (French mark for solid silver 950/1000).
- o Master goldsmith hallmarked twice: TT une plume et un soc de charrue for Théodore TONNELIER (working between 1797 and 1838).

## THÉODORE TONNELIER

Théodore Tonnelier is a goldsmith in Paris at 17 bis, rue Chapon. He works between 1799 et 1838. Many pieces of religious goldwork now classified as an historical monument came from its workshops. Three solid silver timpani are kept at Le Petit Palais in Paris1.
