born April 2, 1969 in Zywiec, is a Polish painter
and collector. Andrzej Borowski graduated from
the Krakow Academy of Fine Arts in 1994 in the
studio of Professor Zbyslaw Maciejewski, at the
time when Professor Jan Szancenbach was rector
of the Krakow Academy of Fine Arts. His works
stylistically refer to Krakow modernism,
supplemented by new means of expression,
which, according to art historian Zofia Weiss can
indicate the phenomenon of the formation of a
new direction in the history of the Polish painting.
(...) The work of Andrzej Borowski corresponds
to the entire term of "dreamlike neorealism". The
