Province of Ayutthaya, Thailand Late 17th - early 18th century Bronze H. 5; L 3.6 cm (old accident)

This bronze Buddha head is particularly elegant: its closed eyelids are incised as if to express wisdom, its lips are finely drawn, its nasal bridge extends into two eyebrow arches and its earlobes are particularly elongated - this last feature refers to the heavy jewellery that Prince Siddharta used to wear.

Lastly, his headdress is punctuated by a succession of small beads around which Buddha's characteristic protuberance, known as the
