Charles Arthur Bourgeois was born on May 19, 1838 in Dijon and died on November 11, 1886 in Paris, was a French sculptor, He was admitted to the Paris School of Fine Arts on October 1, 1857. In 1862 he won the head of expression prize, he won the Rôme prize in 1863; From 1863 Bourgeois exhibited regularly at the salon of French artists, he received several medals, notably a third class medal during of the Universal Exhibition of 1878.
