Description

Marble terminal clock enhanced by a black lacquered wooden base, topped with a brown patina bronze representing the Virgin and Child and young St John holding a large cross. The bronze as well as the mechanism were produced by one of the most prestigious foundry in the history of France known for its exceptional quality and fine carving of its bronzes, CHARPENTIER et Cie 8 rue Charlot Paris in 1860. The company continued its activity under the name Lemerle-Charpentier between 1870 and 1890. During the Universal Exhibition in Paris in 1878, the Lemerle-Charpentier bronziers presented decorations, vases, torchieres, and a large and impressive clock by Piat. The dial with Roman numeral, brass rim and beveled glass is signed, the mechanism is stamped and numbered
