Michel Boillot born in the land of Cézanne, in Aix-en-Provence, has been an artist since a very young age, from the age of 12, he drew tirelessly with passion. After the baccalaureate, Michel Boillot went to Paris where he attended the workshop of Maître Corlin (a disciple of Renoir), and followed the applied arts courses in Paris. He made escapades on a moped, crisscrossing France and Switzerland, but in 1963, he arrived and opened his workshop in La Chartre sur le loir with his wife. He had been practicing his art for four years in a room in the north tower of the Saint-Sulpice church in Paris! Right away, he can respond to requests from residents who want to personalize the entrance to their home. Success grew from year to year, reaching a peak around 1980. He specialized in ceramics and grand feu

decoration. The ceramist paints his tiles by hand with colored oxides on a white enamel spread "with a spoon" by his wife. Flowers, birds, interlacing are the basic ornaments. Now aged 85, he admits to having taken his foot off the gas. He has been officially "retired" since 2017.
