Large oil on canvas depicting, against the backdrop of the village and its bell tower, a wooded meadow where chickens are pecking under the gaze of a farmer. This painting is signed lower left Galiany, pseudonym of Galien-Laloue. Painting in very good condition. Note, two small old restorations in the sky. Important wooden and gilded stucco frame with rich decoration. Dimensions of the canvas 38x55 cm. Total dimensions, with frame, 59x75 cm. Eugène Galien-Laloue, famous painter of the Belle Epoque born in Paris on December 11, 1854 and died in Chérence on April 18, 1941, painted numerous works such as landscapes under various pseudonyms such as Dupuy, Galiany, Juliany or Liévin in order to escape to the exclusivity contracts by which he was bound.
