Gilded brass and bleached deer antler

H.: 15cm - Diam. of base: 5.6cm

Body in bleached deer antler imitating ivory, entirely and finely carved with interlaced foliage incorporating flowers. The upper part forms a bead carved with a garland of oak leaves and acorns.

Mounted in gilded copper, with a three-position measuring spout. Spring-loaded valve. Signed BOCHE in PARIS.
