King Solomon, renowned for his wealth and power, receives a visit with great pomp, from the fabulously beautiful and fabulously rich Queen of Sheba, at the head of an immense caravan filled with precious products (gold, precious stones and herbs) which she offers to King Solomon. It is reported to the king that the Queen of Sheba and her people worship the sun, a symbol found in the border. The tapestry is in good condition, with its bright colors. Small usual restorations.
