A rare and beautiful alcove wall cartel signed Verdier in Paris the famous watchmaker at the beginning of the 18th century, it is a remarkable piece and the mechanism is slightly older than the gilded wood which is Louis XV. The white enamel "bossed" dial is magnificent with its Roman and Arabic numerals, it is an unusual and very complete piece, I do not recommend making it work although after seeing a watchmaker it can be done. , it is an anthology piece of Regency period watchmaking and a beautiful complete decorative element. The mechanism is beautiful and healthy and the gilded wood cartridge is adorned with a beautiful ornamental movement with beautiful, well-carved foliage and beautiful gilding around the dial surrounded by a crown of braided laurel leaves.
