Antoine Jean Desplan, born in Paris (Saint-Merri parish) on June 7, 1790, student of Charles Percier, admitted on August 9, 1813. Honorable mention at the Rome Competition on September 19, 1818 (A Public Walk for a Great City), 1st class on May 28, 1819, won the 1819 Annual Encouragement Prize (with 6 Medals), left the School on May 30, 1820 (replaced by Henri Labrousse), spent three years in Italy (architect in Paris; architect of the City of Paris; inspector of works at the Institute of the Deaf and Mutes, and at the Alfort Veterinary School, between 1824
