The upper section with a surmounted by an ornate fretted brass gallery, above a pair of brass astragal glazed doors, enclosing one adjustable shelf, the lower section with well figured fitted secretaire drawer enclosing an arrangement of ivory handled drawers and pigeonholes with carved round brass handles, above a pair of well figured cupboard doors centered by circular flamed panels with inlay, opening to reveal adjustable shelf, standing on inlaid square block feet. Stunning quality. Original warm patina. keys with working locks. England c.1800.
