The bud is made up of a flower surrounded by its foliage. The pouring spout is shaped like a duck's head. Weight: 530g H: 16cm Bordeaux 1777/78 Master Goldsmith: Jean Eymeric Bordeaux master in 1770) . The teapots are generally pear-shaped and enriched with a rocaille decoration. Ovoid models are rare. The duck's head spouts are characteristic of the generality of Bordeaux. ref: 348
