Gam pectoral in melo-melo shell - Papua New Guinea Important pendant called Parure des Grands Hommes. It is made up of part of the shell called Melo-Melo, which is particularly important. Holes allow a rope to pass through, allowing it to be worn like a breastplate. Beautiful surface patina. Tiny accident on the shell, probably of natural cause. This shell, used by the Dani people, will have traveled kilometers to reach the Highlands region.
