Modern tapestry representing a pastoral scene with three characters in the style of the 18th century. Wool tapestry with printed decoration, lined with burlap with wall fixings on the back (wrought iron) over the entire length. Absence of Bolduc. Around 1950. Jules Pansu. Gobelins. Paris. Tapestry after F. Boucher (1703-1770). Boucher was superintendent of the Manufacture des Gobelins from 1755. His cartoons met with immense success. Reflecting a kind and refined era, his work is entirely focused on love, libertinage and parties. Nature is for him a pretext for graceful compositions where shepherds and shepherdesses are mainly concerned with love, flowers and music. From F. Boucher (1703-1770).
