Blue and white with Japanese inspiration, with a bone delicately placed on cherry blossom branches. Émile Gallé 1846 1904, glassmaker, ceramist and designer, is known as one of the most outstanding glass artists of the 19th century. He was also a pioneer of the Art Nouveau movement. Gallé was born in Nancy, France, in the home of an earthenware and furniture manufacturer. The designer began learning the art of tin-glazed pottery at an early age.
