Bronze print, with nuanced brown patina, depicting a ram by Isidore Bonheur .Bronze signed "I.BONHEUR", hollow, on the naturalistic oval terrace, richly chiseled. Mark of the founder "PEYROL" .Old edition sculpture, period second part of the 19th century .Very good state of conservation and patina .Dimensions: 28 cm x 29 cmIsidore Jules Bonheur (1827-1901) Isidore Bonheur was a French painter and sculptor .Isidore first received artistic training from his father Raymond and his older sister Rosa, then, in 1827, he entered the École des Beaux-Arts in Paris . After practicing painting, he sent a plaster group to the Salon of 1848 an "African Horseman attacked by a lioness"; he thus moved towards animal sculpture. His group "Bull Fight" was noticed at the Salon of 1850 .He Dealer

then mainly composed groups of small animals .Isidore Bonheur obtained medals in the Salons of 1865 and 1869, and a gold medal at the Universal Exhibition of 1889 in Paris .He was decorated with the Legion of Honor in 1895.
