He frequented the workshops of Cormon and Gustave Colin and his first paintings were about the Creuse valley. The Black Valley where he is based inspires him in his landscape paintings. He exhibited in Paris at the Salon of the Société Nationale des Beaux-Arts from 1912. He lived successively in Éguzon, Châteauroux, Thevet-Saint-Julien and Nohant-Vic. He died on October 12, 1948 in the workshop he had built in
