The basha masende are the members of society who hold the necessary knowledge to intervene with the gods. This Baluba (or Luba) mask is the sum of symbolic meanings such as among others: the female mask called kilume, has no crest at the top and has fine incisions painted white. Colors express the character traits or mindset of the wearer. White symbolizes positive aspects such as purity, peace, the moon, light. Red is associated with blood, fire, courage, strength and negative magic... The streaks visualize the path of the dead who await their reincarnation while the vertical axis of the nose represents the tree of life. , as here, the fleshy lips attest to speaking
