Description

Disciple of Fra Angelico (1395-1455), Title: A Pair of Paintings with Angel Musicians" This pair of paintings with angels playing music was created and framed in Florence in the late 19th century by a disciple Italian by the famous Renaissance painter Fra Angelico (1395-1455). He was born in Florence, between 1420 and 1422 he entered a monastery of San Domenico in Fiesole. He painted altarpieces and manuscripts. Linaiuoli altarpiece, a triptych encased in a marble sanctuary, was an early masterpiece, but he went on to paint famous frescoes at the monastery of San Marco in Florence and a chapel in the Vatican. He died in 1455.
