Roche Bobois is the story of how the managers of two stores met in the 1960s at the Copenhagen Fair: Philippe and François Roche on one side, and Jean-Claude and Patrick Chouchan of the "Au Beau Bois" boutique on the other. They wanted to stop making furniture and join forces to import Scandinavian furniture. The following year, Roche Bobois set up franchises while continuing this import model, expanding their range to include Italian furniture and collaborating with Hans Hopfer, Christian
