Pierre -Jules Mêne created the plaster version of this model in 1846, then modeled a bronze version, the same year in his Workshop, it will be exhibited at the Paris Salon of 1849. Exclusive publisher of his works, the perfection of its productions is widely recognized. Bronze sculpture with nuanced brown patina. Bronze signed "PJMÊNE 1849", hollow, on the naturalist terrace, richly chiseled and decorated. Bronze from an old edition, period second part of the
