Émile Baes, born in Brussels on November 12, 1879 and died in Paris in 1954, is a Belgian painter, engraver, art critic and writer. Painter of women, nudes, figures and historical scenes. Studied at the Brussels academy, completed his training in Paris with Bonnat and Cabanel. Exhibited in Paris and Brussels ("Princesse d'Amour", Le Roy gallery). Marked by Flaubert and symbolism. Orientalist tendency. Iconography of the femme fatale (Salome, Messaline, Cleopatra). Literary activities parallel to his painting. He wrote "The sadistic gods", "Princess of Love"...
