Papuan sculpture called "Yipwon" collected in the village of Sevenbuck in Papua New Guinea. The Yipwon is one of the most stylized and symbolic objects from the Sepik River area. It represents a two-dimensional character with ribs, his heart located in the central part and the head. Its other name, wanleg (from English "one leg") in Pidgin English, designates all the figures of this style that we encounter in the Korewori River area. Wood and shells. Old missing on the foot.
