Description

Carved wooden watch holder from the Black Forest* in the shape of a portico clock with columns, decorated with small birds, shells and foliage, from the 19th century. This watch holder is in good condition, very decorative. Note: some old worms, some scratches and wear from time, see photos. * Black Forest or Black Forest Carved wooden objects from the Black Forest did not originate in Germany but were made in the Brienz region of Switzerland. The tradition of woodworking is ancestral in this region, the inhabitants perpetuate the practice of carved wood on the facades of houses, furniture or everyday objects. The sculptors excel in particular in the representation of wild animals in their natural environment. In the 19th century, these naturalistic sculptures from the black forest
