M. Blau published in Nancy by Grimblot,
Thomas and Raybois in 1838. Joseph François
(1729-1813), trained in the business world,
preferred law and letters: member from the
Academy of Nancy (1765), mayor of the city,
professor of history at the Ecole Centrale de la
Meurthe (1796), principal at the Lycée de Lyon
(1803-1805), he ended his career in Nancy. This
collection includes Chaptal's response to the
creation of the École centrale de la Meurthe. The
author comes from a family of traders and shows
a lot of interest in economics. His text on Colbert
was published in Paris, the eulogy of Charles III
was published in Frankfurt and contains his
frontispiece. Collection of rare and most
representative texts by Joseph-François Coster.
The work begins with the Éloge de M. Coster by
Blau, published in Nancy in 1838.
