Brass frame, beaded cap topped with a dome with a short tail. Buffalo horn rocket with twisted brass wire filigree. Joining arch with 2 secondary branches connected to the plate ending in an inflected beak. Blade with 1 edge and 2 hollow sides, marked "BALP" (ST-ETIENNE) and blade tie present. Metal scabbard with 1 bracelet and bail ring. Length: 110 cm Length without sheath: 108 cm Blade length: 92 cm Blade width at the heel: 2.8 cm Good state of conservation and use, in its original condition and patina, see details in the photos.
