



Military Empire Painting Nicolas Toussaint Charlet



Description

Oil painting on panel from the early 19th century representing a singing officer by Nicolas Toussaint Charlet. Very interesting painting first of all for its subject, genre scene painting representing a lieutenant singing at the top of his lungs in an assembly or in a tavern and the remarkable quality of production mastered by this great painter of militaria. Nicolas Charlet 1792 1840 was a great painter specializing in scenes from the first empire, friend of Gericault with whom he traveled to England. He was a student of Gros and is present in the museums of Lyon Évreux and Orléans. Very good-natured, he liked to drink and sing, an amusing parallel with this painting.
