He is about to eat a cherry. At the top left, we can see a butterfly. Beveled frame in gilded brass. Contemporary artist work. Dimensions : H 85,3 x W 66 x D 2 cm Possibility of forming a pair with another panel that we present, a parrot looking to the left! Scagliola, from the Italian Scaglia, which means "scale", also called "marble stucco", which is an inlay technique imitating marble and hard stones, based on selenite and pigments. This technique, which was created at the beginning of the Seicento in Italy, became fashionable because it was an effective substitute
