The fact that she is holding an envelope and what appears to be a letter could indicate a role as a messenger, perhaps of news or knowledge. This could symbolize the transmission of wisdom or ideas through time. The clock positioned inside a half column recalls classical architecture, evoking stability, duration and the order of the universe.
