Small living room unit in solid walnut with a drawer with chiseled rings and bronze mascarons in the belt with inlays of ebony fillets on its front. Below, this small living room unit opens with a double door, with lens buttons with original rosettes, mounted on offset pivots, decorated with inlaid ebony fillets forming a diamond within a rectangle. This decorative theme is also present on each upright as well as on the sides of the furniture. The whole rests on covered feet ending in brass shoes. The top, refined by a slight bevel below, is composed of a dark miter-cut frame of a single board. Through its strict appearance and its rectilinear decorations, this small living room piece of furniture will appeal to lovers of transitional Louis XVI/Directoire style furniture.
