Description

An oil on panel measuring 81X65 cm (without the tabernacle frame) representing a church signed lower right and dated 1920 by Jean Du Marboré (1896-1933).

French painter and engraver born January 4, 1896, died in Paris in 1933. Du Marboré is the name of a mountain in the Pyrenees that he had chosen as a pseudonym, his real name was Jean Pitsh. Coming from a modest background, Jean Du Marboré was self-taught. Painter of portraits, landscapes, post-cubist still lifes. He has exhibited regularly since 1922 at the Salon d'Automne and the Salon des Indépendants in Paris. His Montmartre workshop was located next to that of his friend: SEI KOYANAGUI (1896 - 1948). He died prematurely in 1933. One of these
