Sarreguemines, earthenware toiletries.

Octagonal shape with edges, ivory paste.

Decorated with black Greek friezes on gold strips highlighting the edges.

Stamp printed "SARREGUEMINES" with U&C overprinted on all pieces, with the exception of the toilet bucket, which bears the stamp of the Grand Dépôt E. Bourgeois. This reseller always replaced the manufacturer's stamps with his own stamp on the objects put up for sale in his establishment.

- 1 bowl - height 12.60 cm, diameter 37.50 cm
- 1 toilet bucket - height 33.50 cm (lid socket included), diameter 22.50 cm

- 1 soap box - height 9.50 cm, length 14.40 cm,
width 9.30 cm

- Brush box - height 8.50 cm, length 21.30 cm,
width 7.50 cm

- Sponge bowl - height 7 cm, diameter 18.7 cm

Condition:

- Sockets glued to the lids of the toilet bucket and
the brush box.

- Minimal chips on the edge of the mobile drainer
of the soap box and on the edge of the mobile
drainer of the sponge bowl.
