Description

Pretty pair of decorative oval-shaped dishes with scalloped outlines representing a couple of Breton characters dressed in their traditional costumes. Each character rests on a terrace between two exuberant shingles of bright colors, red, blue and green. The man wears his round hat, his large stick called "Penn-Bazh" as well as his traditional wide short, baggy breeches called "Bragou-Braz". The woman, for her part, wears her apron as well as a traditional headdress. The wing of each dish is decorated with a hand-crafted decoration representing a garland of stylized foliage. The outline is decorated with a small blue net. The inscription HR Quimper is inscribed in the decor under the terrace, this brand was used by the Henriot factory for the period from 1904 to 1922. Dimensions for each dish: length 30.5 cm width
