Cute gilded bronze seal signed on the back "L. Madrassi F.N" depicting a pensive cherub. Monogrammed base.

Luca Madrassi, a French sculptor of Italian origin, began his artistic studies in Rome, then went on to study at the École des Beaux-Arts in Paris, where he was a pupil in the studio of Pierre-Jules Cavelier, then in that of Albert-Ernest Carrier-Belleuse. Between 1876 and 1880, Madrassi was Gustave Doré's practitioner, and is also said to have worked for Antoine Bourdelle. Luca Madrassi exhibited at the Salon de la Société des Artistes français in Paris from 1874. He received several honorable mentions and a third-class medal in 1896. He obtained French nationality and became a
