Introduced to painting very early on by his mother, a painter and musician. From 1978, attended Philippe Lejeune's course at the Atelier de la Vigne in Etampes. The latter will become his master, and Christoff Debusschere one of the most talented current representatives of the Ecole d'Etampes. Christoff Debusschère's favorite subjects are the atmospheres of unusual places such as ports, old hangars, theaters and even interiors. For the light that reveals them, he also likes old planes, carcasses of all kinds and mechanical parts. He received the silver medal then the gold medal at the Salon des artistes français, the Taylor prize awarded by the Salon
