During the First World War, the FA Lattmann company in Goslar (Lower Saxony) published two war games, the Patriotic Playing Cards (dated 1914). These cards here were designed by J.Schonfelder. The manufacturer's mark is visible on the base of the glans, the name on the base of the bell. The kings are Wilhelm II of Württemberg (acorn), Ludwig III of Bavaria (leaf), Kaiser Wilhelm II of Prussia (heart) and
