



## Jp Dussautoy Stamped Mahogany Chiffonier Table From The Louis XVI Period



## Description

Magnificent mahogany chiffonier table from the Louis XVI period, it opens with three drawers on the front and rests on four fluted legs joined by a spacer white marble top (uneven) and bronze gallery stamped DUSAUTOY Jean-Pierre Jean-Pierre Dusautoy (1719-1800) Carpenter-cabinetmaker. Paris. Master on September 1, 1779. He marked with his stamp with large clumsy characters many small pieces of furniture: especially small bedside tables, round, rectangular or oval. Jean-Pierre Dusautoy set up his workshop on rue de Charonne where he worked all his life. Its furniture, in Louis XV, Transition and Louis XVI style, is of good quality, light and elegant in shape. Louis XV and Transition productions are generally decorated with flower marquetry and crosspieces or plain
