Initialed "H.S.F." and dated 1630

The object in question represents a coat of arms in polychrome and gilded wood, referable to the Lombard manufacture of the seventeenth century, signed and dated in its central part "H.S.F. 1630", initials of the representative family. Between the two writings appears the image of a bird with sword, typical heraldic elements, all circumscribed by a golden oval frame. The ends of the shield are decorated by two heads of

cherubim whose wings, also golden, surround the central part.

The coat of arms was also called "weapon" because the term derives from the armor that the knights wore in the Middle Ages and on which their coats of arms effigiavano, which we find painted on the shields and embroidered on the coat and the gualdrappa of their horses. The only shield with the coat of arms allows in fact to identify a family, but you need weapons to identify the individual since they are also represented in the elements that indicate, for example, any titles of nobility of the family and the person.
