Delivery from 40 to 90 euros Joël Desbouiges is a French visual artist, painter, illustrator, photographer, lithographer and sculptor born in 1950 in Mailhac-sur-Benaize. In October 1967, he returned to the National School of Decorative Arts in Limoges, where he took drawing lessons from Claude Viallat. May 1968 brought him the conviction that "his paintings will carry messages" and he began to paint according to the principles of Support/surface a series of large format free canvases on the theme Characters/Violence. He denounces "the violence with which our society timelessly struggles". During his five years of study at ENAD in Limoges, he met Raoul Haussmann and learned about the works of Robert Motherwell, Meret
