Very beautiful and important curved chest of drawers in leaf-inlaid rosewood veneer in frames, It opens with 4 drawers in 3 rows, The uprights and feet are arched, The 3 sides are curved, Rich ornamentation of chiseled and gilded bronzes with foliage decoration, rocaille motifs, acanthus, Falls, sabots and cul de lamps, Royal red marble top with corbin beak, Chest of drawers of rare quality, In good house condition, no lack of bronze, requiring a beautiful restoration for restore its original luster, varnish and cleaning of the bronzes, tiny little polishing gaps on the border of 2 drawers, Louis XV period marble, it has been perfectly restored, JME hallmarks Jurande hallmark twice, We can entirely attribute it to François Antoine Mondon, by its quality and these stylistic characteristics.
