its inhabitants through his painting. Its bright and colorful palette wonderfully transcribes the colors of the shores of the Mediterranean.

In 1941, the artist completed admirable paintings for the interior of the Franciscan Church of L'île Rousse, restoring to this place of worship its primary function of meditation and prayer.

He participates in numerous exhibitions both in mainland France and in Corsica, where his talent is rewarded and praised by critics.
