Detailed photos will prove to you that embroiderer was both an expert in handling colors and in ornithology. Eagle represented here, which resembles a Golden eagle, is perhaps a Borelli's eagle, white neck and white spot on base of beak.

In any case, it is a beautiful work, dated 1807, and signed by the embroiderer, whom we thank 2 centuries later.
