Description

RECIPON (1860-1920) & MULLER (1823-1889) Ceramic flare. The only example known to date. Height 176 cm.

Here we present an important ornamental glazed ceramic torchiere representing the figure of Eury nome holding a Leviathan. Signed lower right "RECIPON" and "E. MULLER", stamped inside "EMILE MULLER IVRY PARIS".

Georges Recipon, French painter and sculptor, whose most famous creations are "les Nymphes de la Seine" and "les Nymphes de la Néva" featured in the keys to the Alexandre-III bridge in Paris (1900) as well as the two quadrigas in the Grand Palais in Paris (1900).

Dealer

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In 1854, Émile Muller founded the Grande Tuilerie company in Ivry-sur-Seine, specialising in ceramic products for construction and industry, as well as artistic ceramics.
