The two engravings are by Antoine Léon Morel - 1810 Rouen 1871 Paris - painter, draftsman, illustrator, engraver, watercolorist, he was curator of the Marine and Ethnographic Museum of the Louvre which he created, assistant curator of the Imperial Museums . The fertility goddess Ceres, after a drawing by Jean-Pierre Granger, 1779 Paris - 1840 Paris, painter who worked in the neo-classical style. And Ygiée goddess of health, cleanliness and hygiene, after a drawing by Bertolini. They are nicely framed and in good condition. The Ceres engraving has some light stains.
