Louis it is in fact two doors opening in the style of a sideboard.

a regional work probably from the south of France where the mixture of styles was sometimes practiced in the 18th century, the crossbow facade therefore recalls the regency, the paneled ribs are still inspired by Louis XIV and the shell feet as well as the scalloped crosspieces bring to the Louis The fronts of the drawers are inspired by Louis beautiful piece of furniture. original lock and key as well as the bronze lock entrance from the Louis XV period. traces of wood-eating insects on this furniture but a preventive treatment with xylophene was carried out in the workshop and there is no longer any presence of insects. the shell feet were redone in the 19th century.
