Nancy, Chez Paul Barbier, 1701; in-12, VIII-238 + 147 + II-396 pp., period full calfskin bindings, spine with decorated bands, restoration of caps and joints. Noel 3886. First edition of this work which contains the ordinance of July 1701. In 1701, Leopold attempted major reforms. A first ordinance in June, the Léopold Code, attempts to establish a civil status like in France, more rigorous with stamped paper. This July ordinance concerns the administration of justice and contains civil procedure and criminal procedure, regulations for offices and officers and regulations for water and forests.
