VERY BEAUTIFUL AND RARE PLAQUE, IN SOLID BRONZE (CAST) WITH A WEIGHT OF 5 KG, 42 CM HEIGHT UNIVERSAL SUFFRAGE IS ESTABLISHED BY THE SECOND REPUBLIC, HENCE THE REPRESENTATION OF THE BOX AND THE INITIALS "SU" ON IT. THIS PLATE DATES FROM THIS PERIOD, AFTER THIS PERIOD UNDER THE SECOND EMPIRE, THE PLATES ARE MADE OF STAMPED BRASS. SYMBOLIC OF THE PLATE, REPRESENTING FREEDOM, IN THE FEATURES OF THE GODDESS JUNO, SEATED HOLDING A LICTOR'S BUNDLE IN HER RIGHT HAND, SYMBOL OF JUSTICE AND REPUBLIC. AT HIS FEET, AN URN REFERRING TO UNIVERSAL SUFFRAGE. IN
